TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entry to this competition is free.
- Entry is open to all local children who attend a Primary School in Westernport Water's service area, from Prep to Grade 6, and special needs students who reside in our service area.
- Entries close 5pm, Tuesday 7 September 2021.
- Entries MUST be A3 in size (or A4 and we can double it). Please note only scanned digital entries are being accepted this year.
- Entries will be judged by Westernport Water staff. Posters will be judged against the theme of the Poster Competition and the criteria outlined on the provided competition information document.
- Winners will be announced during 2021 National Water Week (18-24 October).
- Prizes will be awarded to the First, Second and Third place winners of each age category. Each school that has a student enter will also go into a random draw to win \$500 to put towards a sustainability project.
- Prizes cannot be transferred.
- Westernport Water will collect personal information about you so that your child can participate, and we can administer the competition. We may use any personal information that an entrant has provided for the purpose of running the Competition, and in advertisements, publications, media statements and other promotional material associated with the Competition.
- By submitting the entry form, you give Westernport Water permission to publish the entrants first name, school, and age category on its website, in the local newspapers and on its social media channels if the entry is a winning entry.
- By submitting the entry form, entrants will assign a limited copyright of the artwork to the Westernport Water, enabling reproduction of the artwork for public displays and publications (both printed and digital) in conjunction with the competition AND for the purpose of publication in printed and digital material promoting water, including National Water Week in subsequent years. Artists will be credited whenever the posters are used.
- Entries from students under the age of 18 must have adult consent. Acknowledging you have read and accept these terms and conditions by ticking the above box.
